

vs. 1 - All the people did what was evil in the sight of the Lord

vs. 5 - he shall begin to save Israel

vs. 8 - let the man of God you sent, tell us what to do (fleece?)


vs. 9 - and God listened

vs. 11 - I am

vs. 13-14 - not the future, just a reminder to obey

vs. 20 -they fell on their faces to the ground

vs. 23 - God "showed Himself" to them






vs. 3-4, 7 - She is right in my eyes - (God had a plan)

vs. 6 - the Spirit of the Lord rushed upon him (came mightily)

vs. 9 - breaks the Nazirite vow

vs. 17 - on the 7th day he told her because "she pressed him hard"

vs. 19 - and the Spirit of the Lord rushed upon him.






vs. 3 - God used Samson's anger for His purpose


vs. 4 - God used Samson's strength for His purpose

vs. 9-13 - another opportunity for God to show His power through Samson



vs. 14 - the Spirit of the Lord rushed upon him (came mightily)

vs. 18-19 - he was thirsty and God provided





vs. 3 - In spite of his disobedience, God was still faithful

vs. 4 - guard your heart

vs. 15 - "How can you say, I love you, when your heart is not with me?"

vs. 18 - "told her all his heart" — the strongest man made weak by an ungodly relationship

vs. 20 - "I will go out as at other times..." he didn't know the Lord had left him vs. 28 - the first/only time we see Samson pray

### Samson's life

13:1 - "And the people of Israel again did what was evil in the sight of the Lord,"

16:30 - "Then he bowed with all his strength, and the house fell upon the lords and upon all the people who were in it."

- 1. In spite of himself, Samson was used by God. Imagine what he could have done had he been obedient.
- 2. Guard your heart.
- 3. Know where your power comes from. •
- 4. Don't be a "lone leader".
