- Follow up/Check-ins = important for effectiveness in our ministries & walks
- Strong leadership is crucial, but there will be issues = marriage (1 Cor. 7:28)
- Differing gifts, opinions, agendas who's right here?
 - Barnabas "son of encouragement"
 - Paul zealous & driven

15:36-41 / Interpersonal Issues

- Don't see them praying or seeking the will of the Lord together.
- Both Paul & Barnabas had the same heart, just different approaches...agreed to disagree.
- Beauty of issues in the church = grace, forgiveness & redemption 2 Tim. 4:9-11, Col. 4:10
- * Now there are two missions teams!

16:1-4 / Raising Young Leaders

- * This is the young man Paul is writing to in 1st & 2nd Timothy
- Timothy likely saved on the 1st Mission
 1 Tim. 1:2
- * Result of a godly mom, grandma & praying church 2 Tim. 1:5-7, 1 Tim. 4:14
 - Also, discipleship & training- 2 Tim. 3:10-17

16:1-4 / Raising Young Leaders

- * Should be asking what's the deal?
 - What about chapter 15?
 - Gal. 2:3-5 Didn't circ. Titus
 - We don't really know?
 - 1 Tim. 3:2 "Above Reproach"-Pastor Jewish/Gentile Church?
 - 2 Facts a)Timothy was half Hebrew,
 b)He had to be willing

16:5 / Church Grew Daily

- 1. Strengthen in the Faith (Old Believers)
 - We are here to encourage, train & equip believers for the work ministry
- 2. Bring people to Jesus (New Believers)
 - It wasn't Paul saving tons people he taught believers about Jesus & a life in him
 - Sheep beget Sheep

16:6-10 / Vision & Direction

- Hearing the voice of the Holy Spirit can be challenging at times.
 - 1 Kings 19:9-18
- Many times it's as simple as open & closed doors (hard to wait when closed)
 - Paul's heart is right, but God's right timing is different
 - Don't pridefully force open a door!

"26 But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. 27 Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid."

16:11-15 / Divine Appointments

- * No synagogue there? (had to have at least 10 men to start one)
 - Note people are still gathering & prayer no less!
- * Lydia purple dye expensive to make(shellfish), so cloth expensive.
 - She was likely wealthy & influential
- * Lord has to open a person's heart

"32 But I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself."

16:11-15 / Divine Appointments

- You will notice in this chapter 2 different people accept Christ & so do their families
 - You can be a "game changer" for your family
- * Paul is just looking to pray & he gets to a lead a whole family to Christ
- * Just show up & expect the unexpected!

- * Why would this be a trial?
- * Two Reasons
 - 1. Fighting the desire to market Jesus and/or the ministry
 - If you manipulate or market people into the church, the next best thing will market them out!
 - Not Jesus' way Jn 2:12-25

- ➤ Temptation to use & spend money on gimmicks & techniques like "branding" that sometimes have nothing to do with Christ.
- Church's hiring consultants like commercial businesses
- Gospel = we don't want to sell you anything, but give you a gift!
- How will the world know...?

- 2. Mixed Messages
- Satan's lies are like rat poison = 95% good food...it's the 5% poison that will kill you!
- We might think this lady can influence so many people, but you don't want her influencing people in this sinful state! (Jesus silenced Lk. 4:35)
- There's always a catch! (Matt. 4:1-4)

- This is my personal concern when we say we are going to do "everything" the governor says...when we should be doing everything the Lord says!
- Pray for Christian colleges who have some decisions to make regarding Federal funds.
