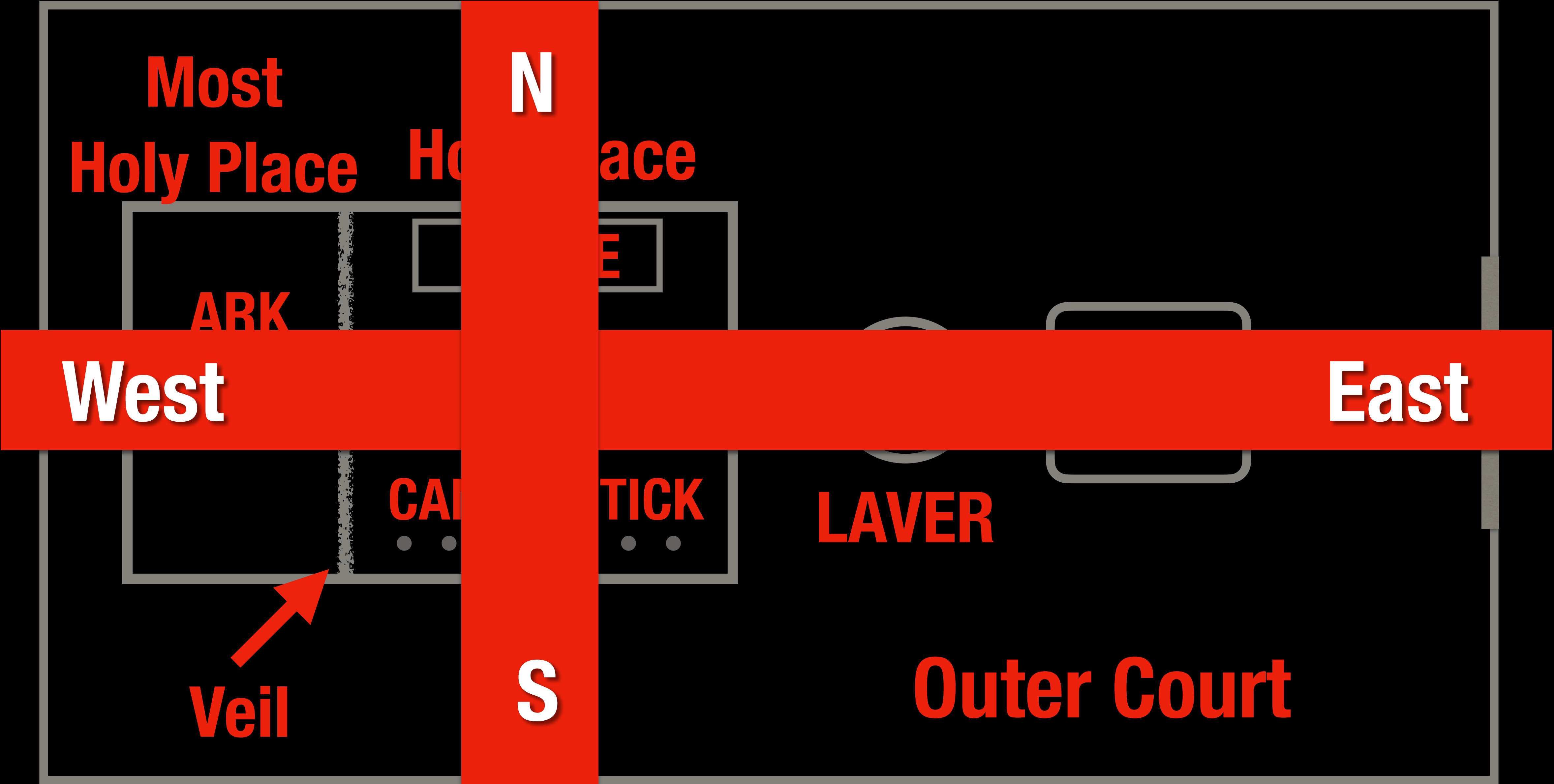

Way to Holiness

- Burnt Offering
 - Grain Offering
 - Fellowship Offering
 - Sin Offering
 - Guilt Offering
- Gave All Himself
 - Bread of Life
 - Jesus is our Peace & Reconciliation
 - Sacrificed for Sin
 - Paid the Price

“10 In bringing many sons to glory, it was fitting that God, for whom and through whom everything exists, should make the author of their salvation perfect through suffering. 11 Both the one who makes men holy and those who are made holy are of the same family. So Jesus is not ashamed to call them brothers.”

NOTES: 7:22 - 38

- There are cultures today that drink blood as part of rituals
- Is God health conscious?
- Fellowship offerings - Priests to wave & heave (1 Tim. 2:8)
- Specific portions given to the priests - 1 Sam. 2:12-16

“10 I also learned that the portions assigned to the Levites had not been given to them, and that all the Levites and singers responsible for the service had gone back to their own fields.”

Nehemiah 13:10 | NIV84

“The elders who direct the affairs of the church well are worthy of double honor, especially those whose work is preaching and teaching. 18 For the Scripture says, “Do not muzzle the ox while it is treading out the grain,” and “The worker deserves his wages.”

1 Timothy 5:17-18a | NIV84

“7 Who serves as a soldier at his own expense? Who plants a vineyard and does not eat of its grapes? Who tends a flock and does not drink of the milk? 8 Do I say this merely from a human point of view? Doesn't the Law say the same thing? 9 For it is written in the Law of Moses: “Do not muzzle an ox while it is treading out the grain.” Is it about oxen that God is concerned?

“ 10 Surely he says this for us, doesn't he? Yes, this was written for us, because when the plowman plows and the thresher threshes, they ought to do so in the hope of sharing in the harvest. 11 If we have sown spiritual seed among you, is it too much if we reap a material harvest from you? 12 If others have this right of support from you, shouldn't we have it all the more?

“ But we did not use this right. On the contrary, we put up with anything rather than hinder the gospel of Christ. 13 Don't you know that those who work in the temple get their food from the temple, and those who serve at the altar share in what is offered on the altar? 14 In the same way, the Lord has commanded that those who preach the gospel should receive their living from the gospel.”

1 Corinthians 9:7-14 | NIV84

NOTES: 8:1-5

- The entire assembly = elders/leaders
Tabernacle could not fit everyone
- Re-telling of Ex. 29 = learn that this was to “Consecrate” the priests

Ordination/Consecration:

- About perfecting & dedicating someone
- Another meaning literally in Hebrew =
“to fill the hand”
 - It’s not about what I am going to do for the Lord or what I bring, but what he will give me to do for him!
- Jesus only did what the Father said

“38 For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me. 39 And this is the will of him who sent me, that I shall lose none of all that he has given me, but raise them up at the last day. 40 For my Father’s will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.”

John 6:38-40 | NIV84

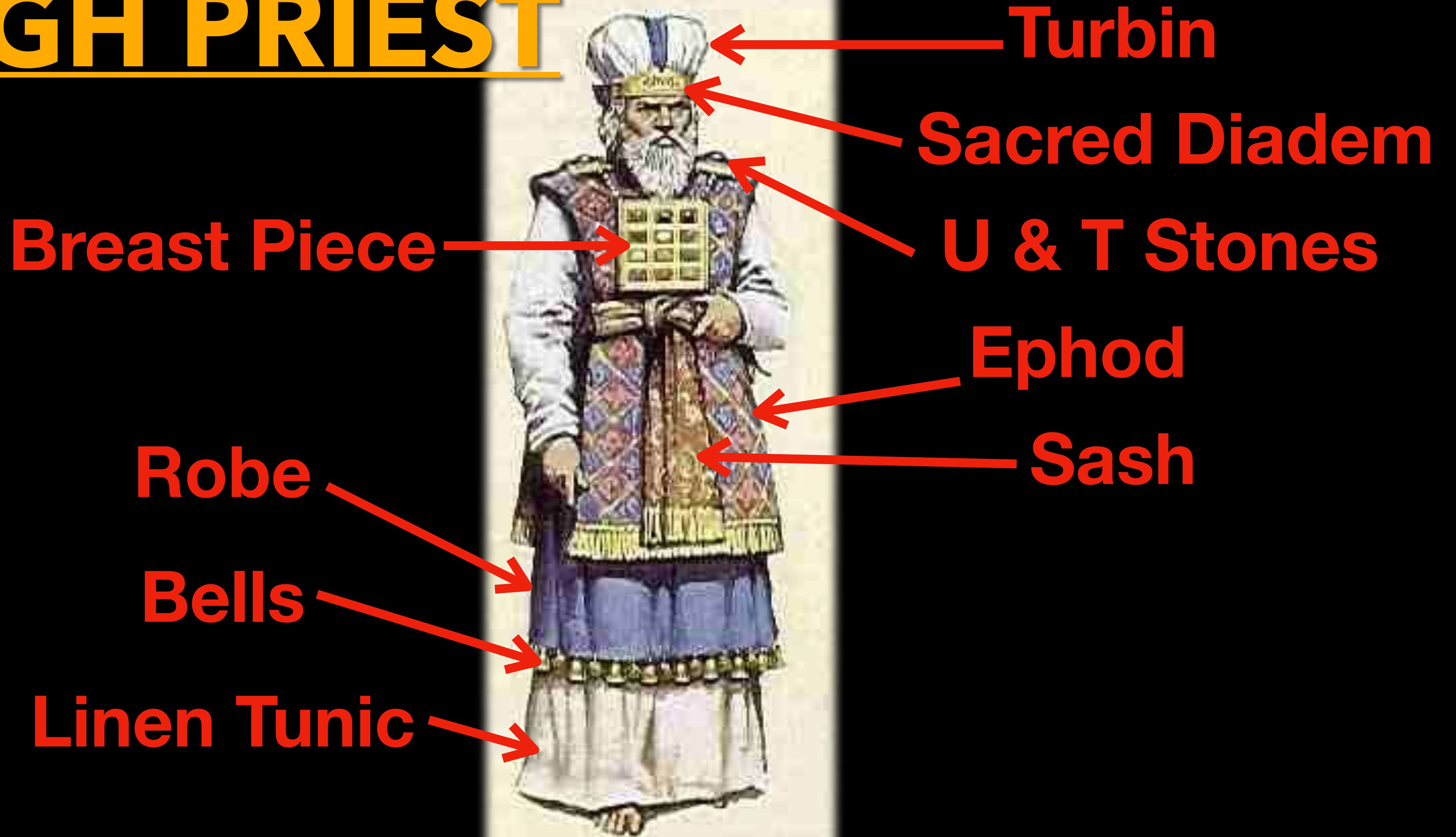

NOTES: 8:6-9

- Likely washed out of the Bronze Laver
- Most of what the priests wore was linen
- the ministry was to be no sweat!
(Jesus Matt. 11:28-31)
- Sacred Diadem = “Holy To The Lord”

HIGH PRIEST



NOTES: 8:10-36

- Anointing Oil - (Ex.30:22-33) Sacred & not to be used anywhere else
- Pic of H.S. - Interesting Ex. 29:43-46
- Sin Offering - just fat burned, rest outside the camp, blood spread
- Two Rams - First one was for Burnt Offering
- 2nd Ram = Special 6th Offering for ordination

NOTES: 8:10-36

- Blood used differently to cover the priests - sprinkled on the priests, put on right ear, thumb & big toe
- Ordination ram kind of like a fellowship offering where the fat is burnt, rest is shared and bread was offered with it - v.31 they cooked & ate it...
- Oil & Blood sprinkled together on Priest
- Spent 7 days with the Lord

NOTES: 8:10-36

- Law = do what the Lord requires “so you will not die”
 - Law could only bring death if not followed perfectly, but the Spirit of Christ brings life because of Christ’s perfect sacrifice

Our Priestly Consecration

1. Gather the entire assembly

- Hebrews 10:19-25, (where 2 or 3 are...)

2. Washed with Water = Baptism

- Jesus (Matt. 3)
- Water of the Word (Eph. 5:26, Jn 15:3)
- Jn 17:17 “Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth”

Priestly Consecration

3. Special Clothes

- Christ was given a purple robe...
- Is. 64:6 our righteousness is filthy rags
- Gal. 3:26-29 - with Christ
- Col. 3:12-17 - these things
- Rom. 13:11-14 - time is now!

Priestly Consecration

4. Anointed with Oil = Holy Spirit

- H.S. Anointed Jesus - Jn. 1:32-34
- Acts 6:3 - men full of the H.S.
- Acts 13:2 - H.S. set apart P & B
- 2 Cor. 1:21-22
- We are a temple of...

Priestly Consecration

5. Sin Offering - Confession

- Jesus was the offering for sin

6. Ordination Offering

- Jesus bled from his head, his hands & his feet!
- Blood on the Ear = dedication to listen to the Lord & understand his Word

Priestly Consecration

- Thumb = Hands dedicated to serve
- Big Toe = committed to walk in the ways of the Lord

7. 7 Days - First ministry = the Lord

- Jesus retreated to the desert, mountain
- Constantly in communion, prayer & in the Word

Priestly Consecration

- So we won't die! - figuratively, spiritually
- How easy it is to get overwhelmed & burn out in ministry!
- Lord has to be first for the Priest, can't forget who you are serving!
- How easy to get caught up in things the Lord did not put in our hands!
