Reuben "See a son" (Leah) Reubanites joined in Korah's rebellion Numbers 16






Simeon "God has heard" (Leah)

Judah "to Praise" (Leah) Headship of the family, but sorted Gen. 37:26-27 - his leadership lead to the sale of Joseph Gen. 38 - Tamar He kind of seems to make things right with each?



Judah "to Praise" (Leah) David's rule brought about what God intended here, but it was short lived (owned the most real-estate in his reign) Direct prophecy about Jesus - "he comes to whom it belongs" (Shiloh) Revelation 5:5 = Lion of Judah



Zebulun "Honor" (Leah) 10th born Supplied the largest number of men to David's army 50k (1 Chron. 12:33) Not right on the sea, but controlled the trade routes




Issachar "Reward or Wages" (Leah) 9th son - dad not totally with it? They are strong & see how good their land is, but not willing to work for it so ultimately ended up in slavery and were the work horses of the nation Targeted by other nations - small size & abundance of their land



Dan "has Vindicated" (Bilhah) Were good fighting men Likened to serpent - introduced idolatry - Judges 18:30, 1 Kings 12:26-30 Revelation 7:4-8 - not listed?





Gad "Good Fortune" (Zilpah)

Fighters, fast on foot, pretty boys!



Joseph "May God Add" (Rachel) Receives double portion of the inheritance & the blessing Though Jo given the blessing Ephraim not listed in Rev. 7 either His inheritance included Sumaria (Jereboam from Ephraim)



Raveness Wolf? Judges 19-21 Levite and concubine (wicked) King Saul from Benjamin Paul also (Phil. 3:5) They did remain faithful to Judah after the split.
