- * These extra offerings were about the Israelite community...special occasions and such
- * Note: it was to be “an aroma pleasing to the Lord” (v. 3, 7, 10)
- * Everyone one was allowed to participate in the same way Alien or Native
- * Sometimes there might be unintentional mistakes in carrying out the regulations

NOTES: Chapter 15

- * Tassels gave a way for people to remember the commands of the Lord & be united in them
- * (v.39) Help people not go after lusts of the own hearts - not a what is good for you & what is good for me situation like we have today.

NOTES: Chapter 16

- * Korah instead of going to Moses with his issues first...went to his friend
- * He didn't go to Mo & Aaron as a leader already to work things out, but opposed
- * What does Mo do when problems hit?
Fell Facedown!
- * Let's pray about it...go to the Lord about it...incense a picture of prayer

NOTES: Chapter 16

- * (v.11) Sound's like you got a God problem...how much more do you need than being close to the Lord & doing his work
- * (v.14) Probably mad about how things went down in chapter 14?
- * (v.15) This is called praying against someone...
- * (v.22-23) Bad leadership affects everyone!

NOTES: Chapter 16

- * No mistaking God's will here...this is what we call ministry burn out!
- * Interesting the censurers become holy after the bad leadership is removed & becomes a sign for the Israelites
- * (v.41) How can they grumble again!
- * Korah's heart infected everyone
- * Only remedied by incense & fire

NOTES: Chapter 16

- * (v.48) **Intercession & ministry is life or death!**

Jude's Picture of Poor Leaders

- **Godless = not Spirit filled**
- **Change Grace = use as a license to sin**
- **Deny Christ - use only by name...he's not everything**
- **Polluted = sexual immorality & perversion**
- **Dreamers - visionaries?**
- **Reject Authority = No accountability from other leadership or even the Bible**

Jude's Picture of Poor Leaders

- **Slander - ministries, etc...don't understand Function on instinct = feeling/emotion**
- **Feed selves = all about them**
- **Clouds without rain = nothing substantial in what they are teaching**
- **Blown along by the wind...of trends**
- **Fruitless**
- **Wild Waves - popular by stirring the pot**

Jude's Picture of Poor Leaders

- **Wandering stars = you are on their emotional rollercoaster & there when they eventually burnout**
- **Grumblers & Fault Finders**
- **Flatterers & Charmers - good at itching ears**
