Micah 6:1-8

Micah 1:1

- ◆ Moresheth
- ◆ 8th century BC, probably around 735BC
- ◆ Jotham, Ahaz, Hezekiah
- ◆ Divided Kingdoms

2 Kingdoms, 3 Kings

- ◆ Israel in north, Judah in south
- ◆ Jotham - 11th king of Judah after Solomon - 2 Kings 15:32-38
- ◆ Ahaz - reigned 16 years - 2 Kings 16
- ◆ Hezekiah - none like him before nor after - 2 Kings 18:1-8; 2 Chronicles 29-32

Context for Micah

- ◆ Political unrest and wars
- ◆ Many religions and religious liberality
- ◆ Devaluation of human life
