- 8th century BC, probably around 735BC
- Jotham, Ahaz, Hezekiah
- Divided Kingdoms

2 Kingdoms, 3 Kings

- Israel in north, Judah in south
- Jotham 11th king of Judah after
 Solomon 2 Kings 15:32-38
- Ahaz reigned 16 years 2 Kings 16
- Hezekiah none like him before nor after - 2 Kings 18:1-8; 2 Chronicles 29-32
