

- #2 Entrusted with God's Work
  - Discipline (Ps. 23:4 rod & staff)
    - Refute those who oppose the truth (Titus 1:9)
    - Carry out Matt. 18:15-20
    - Open to it themselves- 1 Tim. 5:19-20

- #3 Direct Church Affairs (1 Tim. 5:17)
  - Vision, goals, mission & purpose
  - See in Acts 11 oversaw money, made sure gifts were appropriately used
    - What about the Financial Board?
      - Only a "Check & balance" = for nonprofit 501c3 status (Not the ruling body = deacons)

- #3 Direct Church Affairs (1 Tim. 5:17)
  - Overseeing practical week to week
    - Plugging people into minstries
    - Appointing leaders & staff
    - Checking what is taught
    - Conducting services
    - Jump in where needed

- #4 <u>Prayer</u>
  - James 5:14-17 especially the sick
  - Similar to the apostles Acts 6:3-4 = prayer & the word
- Can be paid staff or volunteer equal value & authority
