Book of Numbers - Victorious Life

A winning walk or victorious life are directly related to conduct & commitment to others as well as the Lord

conduct = looking for people who are striving for purity & holiness (like God) - moving heavenward!

NOTES: Chapter 6

- * Nazirite = “to set apart, to dedicate
- * Note: they didn't become monks & drop out of society = 3 requirements
 1. Drink nothing fermented or even eat anything related
 2. Can't touch anything dead...not even family
 3. No cutting of the hair = sign

- * This vow is calling for a serious commitment...it was about growth & devotion spiritually.
- * What would happen if more people gave up things like alcohol for their growth and that of others?
