

Study Guide Wk3 Matthew 28:18-20

WE JOIN GOD in his unfinished mission – the Great Commission (Mt. 28:18-20) until all have had opportunity to hear and respond to His invitation. Will we join Him? Missions Emphasis in The Alliance is our chance to answer this question in the way He whispers it to us today. Will I do what he asks, joining him in finishing his mission? Will I give? Will I be a prayer warrior? Will I minister to those in our city for whom it's been made difficult to turn to God? Am I willing to go serve peoples of the world still living without access to the good news?

Questions

What part of the message stood out to you the most? Why?

What active steps are you taking to help complete Jesus' command for all believers? How are you growing as a disciple of Jesus? Has your obedience to Jesus grown? How are you replicating yourself?

In what way(s) is our mission still an **unfinished mission**? How do you see yourself engaging more wholly in the mission Jesus has given you? What is the role and responsibility of the church in completing the mission?
