Sermon Discussion Questions - March 20 & 22, 2026**Matthew: Part 2 - Sermon on the Mount****Matthew 7:12-23**

Ice Breaker: *Jesus wraps up the Sermon on the Mount by talking about two different paths we can take.*

- **Q1: Can you think of a time when you had to choose between an easy option and a harder one—and the harder choice ended up paying off? What happened?**

Read Matthew 7:12-23 together. Jesus describes Kingdom citizens as people marked by selfless love—something He sums up in the Golden Rule.

- **Q2: In everyday life, what does it actually look like to put other people's needs ahead of your own?**
- **Q3: What's a time when you experienced or witnessed selfless love that really stuck with you?**

Jesus says the easy path leads to destruction, but the path of selfless love leads to life!

- **Q4: What are some signs that someone is walking on the “narrow path”?**
- **Q5: What are some signs that someone might be on the “wide path”?**

Jesus also warns us that we will encounter false prophets and bad trees along the path to life.

- **Q6: What are some red flags or warning signs of a “wolf in sheep’s clothing”?**
- **Q7: How do you personally discern between a leader who’s genuinely (but imperfectly) following God and one who might be misleading others?**

Jesus says that not everyone who claims to know Him will make it into His kingdom.

- **Q8: How much assurance do you have of your salvation?**
- **Q9: How can you have confidence that it is a true assurance instead of a self-deception?**

True Kingdom Citizens are those who do the will of the Father.

- **Q10: Where do you sense God inviting you to bear more fruit of heart-level obedience to Him this week?**
