<u>Ice Breaker:</u> God invites us into a full and abundant life—a life shaped by Spirit-led generosity.

 Q1: Have you ever witnessed or experienced a powerful act of generosity—something that really stuck with you? What happened?

Read Matthew 25:14-30. This parable reminds us that God trusts us to wisely manage what He's given us.

- Q2: What are some ways fear or comparison can hold us back from being generous with what we've been given?
- Q3: How can you tell the difference between giving out of guilt or pressure vs.
   giving that's genuinely led by the Holy Spirit?

When we faithfully steward what God has entrusted to us, we're preparing to reign with Christ in His Kingdom!

• Q4: How does it challenge or encourage you to think that nothing we have truly belongs to us—that it's all God's?

In the parable, each servant receives a different amount, based on their ability. But the master gives the same praise to the two who used what they were given well.

• Q5: What stands out to you about the fact that both of those servants received the same praise and reward—even though one started with more?

This sermon challenged us to align our budgets with the things that God prioritizes.

- Q6: When it comes to budgeting, how does your family (or you personally)
  approach it? Do you feel like you have a good sense of where your money
  goes?
- Q7: How is it freeing to know that this isn't a "poverty gospel"—that God cares about both our generosity and our well-being/practical needs?

Jesus provides us with the ultimate example of stewardship in His perfect life and ministry.

 Q8: Is there an area in your life where you feel like the Spirit might be nudging you to be more generous or to reexamine how you're using your resources?
