Philippians 1:3-11

Questions:

- Read Philippians 1:3-11. Paul is secure in God's joy towards him, so he is then able to express that joy towards the church in Philippi!
 - How does knowing that God is happy with you allow you to share your joy with other believers?
- Our unity in Christ should result in happy-to-be-togetherness!
 - When you gather with other Christians, how do you show that you are "happy to be together" with them?

- Many kinds of barriers or differences tend to cause disunity, either in the church or in our own spiritual lives.
 - What are some practical ways that we can remind ourselves that our unity in Christ supersedes all differences?
- Paul had unshakeable joy...even in prison! The love of the believers in Philippi contributed greatly to his resolve.
 - Have you ever faced a difficult situation where other believers were able to surround you and help you maintain your joy? Tell your group about it!
- In verse 8, Paul says that he yearns for the believers in the church of Philippi "with the affection of Christ Jesus".
 - Where do you struggle to show or receive affection (i.e. relational warmth) from other believers?
- We all have believers in our lives who are struggling with joy in this season. Maybe it's ourselves, a family member, a close friend, etc.
 - How can you support them and remind them of the love of God this week?
- Reread verses 9-11. Paul lists the following characteristics: *love, knowledge, discernment, purity, righteousness.*
 - Which one is God calling you to develop in this season?
 - Share with your group, and allow them to help you grow in this area!
