**Sermon Discussion Questions - February 6 & 8, 2026****Matthew: Part 2 - Sermon on the Mount****Matthew 5:31-37**

**Ice Breaker:** *This week's passage brought up some heavy (but highly relevant) topics.*

- **Q1: As you think back over the sermon or passage, what is something that stuck out to you—even if you're still chewing on it?**

*Read Matthew 5:31-37 together. Jesus begins by addressing divorce.*

- **Q2: Did anything in this teaching surprise you or challenge how you've understood these verses before?**
- **Q3: Why do you think marriage matters so much to God? Why should we take it seriously when our culture often doesn't?**

*Jesus points to divorce laws as a way that God protects the vulnerable.*

- **Q4: How does Jesus's teaching challenge modern attitudes toward divorce, relationships, or “exit options”?**

*Jesus then shifts to the importance of truthfulness and keeping our word.*

- **Q5: What kinds of situations tempt you to exaggerate, soften the truth, or add disclaimers to sound more convincing?**
- **Q6: What fears or insecurities do you think are usually underneath that temptation?**

*As followers of Jesus, we should aim to be so reliable that no one needs an “I promise” from us.*

- **Q7: Where in your life do you sense a need for greater integrity right now—in your commitments, relationships, or speech?**
- **Q8: As you sit with this passage, where might the Holy Spirit be nudging you toward repentance, support, or realignment with God’s best for you?**
