Sermon Discussion Questions - January 16 & 18, 2025**Matthew: Part 2 - Sermon on the Mount****Matthew 5:17-20**

Ice Breaker: As followers of Jesus, many of us have heard the Bible described as a “rule of life”.

- **Q1: Have you ever followed the rules for something but completely missed the point of it? What happened?**

Read Matthew 5:17-20 together. The Old Testament will always be the authoritative word of God.

- **Q2: When you think about the Old Testament, how do you usually engage with it—confusion, curiosity, fascination, avoidance, something else? Why do you think that is?**
- **Q3: In light of what Jesus said, how do you want to prayerfully grow in your engagement with the Old Testament?**

Seeing the Old Testament as “fulfilled” by Jesus changes the way we approach it.

- **Q4: How does it strengthen or encourage your faith to know that all of Scripture ultimately points us to Jesus?**

When it comes to applying the Old Testament, it's easy to drift toward one of two extremes.

- **Q5: Which direction do you tend to lean toward more—license (ignoring God's commands) or legalism (trying to earn God's approval)? Why?**

The law serves an essential function in our faith—it reveals our sin and our need for a Savior.

- **Q6: Where are you most tempted to downplay or minimize sin in your own life?**
- **Q7: On the other hand, where do you find yourself trying to earn righteousness or God's approval through your own effort?**

The Gospel brings us the gift of New Covenant righteousness—we receive new hearts that can follow God through the work of His Spirit in us.

- **Q8: As you reflect on this passage, is there anything God might be calling you to repent of, surrender, or realign in your walk with Him?**

Take a few minutes to encourage each other, and spend some time in prayer together!
