



Sermon Discussion Questions - May 22 & 24, 2026
Matthew Part 3: Week 3
Matthew 8:23-27

Ice Breaker: *The disciples already trusted Jesus for their daily needs, but in this passage, they had to trust Him with their very lives.*

- **Q1: Have you ever seen God provide in an unexpected or powerful way—either in your own life or someone else’s? What happened?**

Read Matthew 8:23-27 together. We can trust Jesus in every fearful situation that we face.

- **Q2: What are some areas of life where trusting God comes naturally for you?**
- **Q3: What situations or circumstances make it harder for you to trust God?**

As the storm raged around them, the disciples cried out to Jesus for rescue.

- **Q4: When life feels overwhelming or out of control, where are you tempted to turn for comfort, control, or help besides Jesus?**

Following Jesus doesn't keep us from fearful situations. In fact, the disciples were in the storm because they followed Him.

- **Q5: Is there anything in your life right now that is tempting you to fear or causing you to doubt God's care or provision?**
- **Q6: What specifically are you afraid of in those situations? What feels most at stake to you?**
- **Q7: With those things in mind, how might God be stretching your faith, inviting you to trust Him more deeply, or surrender something to His control?**

We can face our present storms with confidence when we remember God's faithfulness in past trials.

- **Q8: Looking back over your life, where have you seen Jesus prove Himself faithful during a difficult season?**
- **Q9: In your current circumstances, where do you most need to remember that Jesus is God and therefore in control?**
