#### Questions:

- Read Matthew 18:16-20. After the resurrection, the disciples waited in anticipation to meet Jesus at the mountain.
  - **Discuss a time when you had to wait in anticipation for something. What were some of the thoughts and feelings you experienced?**
  
- Verse 17 tells us that ALL worshiped, but some doubted. This means that worship and doubt can happen together.
  - **Have you ever had a time when your worship coexisted with your doubts? Tell your group about it!**

- Think about the people who have discipled you throughout your walk with Jesus.
  - **How does the command to “make disciples of all nations” challenge or inspire you personally?**
  
- In Verse 20, Jesus promises to be with us “to the very end of the age”.
  - **How does this promise motivate you to share your faith and engage in discipleship?**
  
- The Great Commission is our greatest call, but that doesn’t make it easy!
  - **What are some common obstacles or fears that you face when it comes to making disciples?**
  
  - **Who in your life have you given up on when it comes to sharing the Gospel? Allow your group to encourage you to keep trying!**
  
- Think through your daily schedule for this upcoming season.
  - **How can you actively work to seize opportunities to make disciples this week? Brainstorm with your group!**
  
- This month has been all about God’s guiding purpose for His church!
  - **What is the main thing you are taking away from our “Bigger Than Me” sermon series?**
  
  - **Where do you want to keep learning and growing when it comes to being a member of the body of Christ?**
