



Sermon Discussion Questions - July 24 & 26, 2026
Matthew Part 3: Week 12
Matthew 11:20-30

Ice Breaker: *This week's passage centers on the theme of humility.*

- **Q1: Can you think of a time when you walked into a situation feeling confident, only to be humbled? What happened?**

Read Matthew 11:20-30 together. In this passage, Jesus reveals Himself to those who recognize they can't save themselves.

- **Q2: When did you first realize you couldn't save yourself and needed Jesus as your Savior?**

It's easy to become so confident in our own understanding or abilities that we begin living as though we don't really need Jesus.

- **Q3: Where are you most tempted to look for approval, power, comfort, or control to give you a sense of security or "being okay" instead of looking to Jesus?**

Jesus says that God reveals the truths of His kingdom to "little children"—those who come to Him with humility and dependence.

- **Q4: In what areas of your life are you most aware of your dependence on Jesus?**
- **Q5: In what areas are you still tempted to rely on yourself instead of depending on Jesus?**

Jesus invites us to come to Him for true and lasting rest—not only the eternal rest He provides, but also the rest we can experience in Him today.

- **Q6: When you're feeling weary or overwhelmed, where do you tend to look for rest or relief instead of turning to Jesus?**
- **Q7: Where do you feel weary, burdened, or in need of Jesus's rest today?**

Jesus promises that His yoke is easy and His burden is light if we lay down our pride and come to Him with childlike faith.

- **Q8: How can you respond to Jesus with humility and child-like faith in an area of need this week?**

Take a few minutes to encourage each other, and spend some time in prayer together!
