**Sermon Discussion Questions - February 27 & March 1, 2026****Matthew: Part 2 - Sermon on the Mount****Matthew 6:19-34**

**Ice Breaker:** *This week's passage talks about the difference between storing up treasures on earth and investing in what lasts forever.*

- **Q1: If someone looked at your bank statement or calendar, what would they guess you value most?**

*Read Matthew 6:19-34 together. Jesus teaches that freedom from worry begins with remembering the glorious inheritance we have in Him.*

- **Q2: On a scale of 1–10, how much of a “worrier” are you? What do you most often find yourself worrying about?**
- **Q3: When you think about your life right now, are you more focused on what you have—or on what you feel is missing?**

*Jesus connects the way we “see” with what’s going on in our hearts.*

- **Q4: How does your perspective on money and possessions affect your joy, contentment, or relationships?**

*Jesus says we can’t serve both God and money.*

- **Q5: In this season of life, where do you feel tension between trusting God and trying to stay in control?**

*Jesus also addresses our tendency to worry about our everyday needs.*

- **Q6: In your experience, what’s the difference between healthy planning and anxious striving?**

*To “seek first the kingdom” means to orient your whole life around God’s rule and trust Him to provide.*

- **Q7: Can you share a time when you clearly saw God provide for you?**
- **Q8: What might it look like for you to practice deeper trust in God this week—whether through generosity, letting go of a specific worry, or taking a step of obedience?**

*Take a few minutes to encourage each other, and spend some time in prayer together!*
