Sermon Discussion Questions - March 13 & 15, 2026**Matthew: Part 2 - Sermon on the Mount****Matthew 7:7-11**

Ice Breaker: *Prayer is an incredible privilege, but many of us don't take advantage of it as often as we should.*

- **Q1: What's the most memorable or miraculous way you've seen God answer a prayer?**

Read Matthew 7:7-11 together. When it comes to prayer, we often approach God like beggars instead of children of the King.

- **Q2: Do you usually experience prayer more as a chore or as something you genuinely enjoy? What makes you feel that way?**
- **Q3: What kinds of lies or doubts keep you from going to God in prayer? (For example: thinking He's too busy, feeling like you don't know how to pray, wondering if He's really listening, etc.)**

Jesus invites us into a life of ongoing prayer—continually asking, seeking, and knocking.

- **Q4: Can you share a time when you had to persistently bring the same request to God over and over again? What did that experience teach you?**

Jesus also reminds us that God is a loving Father who gives good gifts to His children.

- **Q5: Looking back, what are some of the best gifts God has given you in response to prayer?**

This passage points to a powerful truth—there is no such thing as an unanswered prayer for a Christian.

- **Q6: Have you ever experienced a “no” or a “not yet” from God that later turned out to be a blessing—even though it was hard to see at the time?**
- **Q7: In what area of your life is it hardest to trust that God is giving you what’s best? How can this group encourage or pray for you in that area?**

We have this incredible hope—the King of the universe hears and responds to our requests.

- **Q8: What need, struggle, situation, or even simple desire do you feel God inviting you to bring to Him in prayer right now?**

Take a few minutes to encourage each other, and spend some time in prayer together!
