Q1: What are some things you do to help your household run smoothly? What
do you gain when you pitch in — and what happens when you don't?

- Q2: What are some ways you've experienced joy or blessing by being part of the Cornerstone family?
- Q3: Do you feel more like a participant or a consumer in your church community? What might be one next step toward greater ownership?

Read Galatians 6:6-10. The Bible paints a big picture of the local church — not just as a helpful organization, but as Jesus's bride and God's crown jewel.

- Q4: How is the church different from other organizations doing good in the world? Why does that matter when we think about where to give our time and resources?
- Q5: God calls the church His bride and His body. What does that say about how
   He sees it and how should that shape the way we support it?

The local church is the seedbed for all other ministries, both here at home and around the world.

- Q6: Why do you think God designed the local church not just individual
   Christians to be the center of His mission in the world?
- Q7: Read Matthew 16:18-19. How do Jesus's words in this passage give you confidence that investing in the local church is worth it?

As we close out this series, remember: the Generous Life starts and grows right in the heart of the local church.

Q8: What are some big takeaways you've learned from this series? How do you
want to live those out in your everyday life moving forward?
