Sermon Discussion Questions - January 30 & February 1, 2026**Matthew: Part 2 - Sermon on the Mount****Matthew 5:27-30**

Ice Breaker: *This week's passage brought up some heavy (but highly relevant) topics.*

- **Q1: As you think back over the sermon or passage, what was one phrase, idea, or image that stuck with you—even if you're still chewing on it?**

Read Matthew 5:27-30 together. Jesus keeps shifting the focus from outward actions to what's going on in the heart.

- **Q2: Why do you think that shift matters so much—not just when it comes to sexual sin, but for following Jesus in general?**

Jesus frames lust as something that dehumanizes—turning people into objects rather than image-bearers

- **Q3: In what ways does our culture encourage that kind of seeing? Where do you notice it showing up most easily?**

Jesus doesn't just talk about what we do, but the root problems underneath the actions.

- **Q4: What are some underlying things—like stress, loneliness, boredom, insecurity, or exhaustion—that can make lust more tempting or harder to resist?**

The Gospel meets us in a world where sexualized content feels almost unavoidable.

- **Q5: In that reality, what does wisdom look like—both in how we try to limit exposure and how we respond when we're exposed anyway?**

Jesus uses extreme language about removing an eye or hand—not to shock us into shame, but to show us what's at stake.

- **Q6: What would it look like for you to get ruthless with your sin—sexual or otherwise?**

The sermon reminded us that fighting sin is never a solo project—we need other believers!

- **Q7: Why do you think community, honesty, and accountability are so important in this area—even though they can feel awkward or uncomfortable?**
- **Q8: As you reflect this week, where might the Holy Spirit be nudging you toward confession, support, or deeper accountability?**
