<u>Ice Breaker:</u> The Bible isn't just a bunch of random stories—it's one big, connected message of hope.

- Q1: Have you ever studied an entire book of the Bible from start to finish? What was that like for you—what did you enjoy, and what was challenging?
- Q2: This series is going to park us in one part of the Bible for a long time. How are you feeling about that? Excited? Nervous? Somewhere in between?

Read Matthew 1:1-17 together. Genealogies can feel a bit dry or confusing, but they're full of meaning if we take a closer look.

Q3: Be honest—when you hit a genealogy in the Bible, what do you usually do?
 Do you skip it, skim it, or dig in?

Q4: From the message this week, what stood out to you about this genealogy?
 Was there anything surprising or new that caught your attention?

Matthew shows that God kept His promises across many generations—even through some messy and unexpected stories.

 Q5: How does seeing God's long-term faithfulness encourage you in a season where you're waiting or unsure of what will happen?

Matthew also highlights five women in Jesus's family line—Tamar, Rahab, Ruth, Bathsheba, and Mary—which was very unexpected for that time.

- Q6: Why do you think Matthew made a point to include these specific women in the genealogy?
- Q7: What's it like for you to realize that Jesus's family tree includes people that were broken, flawed, or outsiders?

Matthew starts with a mic-drop moment—Jesus is the long-awaited fulfillment of God's covenant promises!

- Q8: Seeing God's faithfulness across generations—how does that strengthen or shape your faith?
- Q9: Is there a promise of God that feels especially relevant for you right now—something He's inviting you to trust Him with more deeply this week?

Take a few minutes to encourage each other and spend some time in prayer together!
