THE FATHER'S HEART FOR PRAYER AND WHY PRAYER IS SO IMPORTANT IN THE LIFE OF THE BELIEVER

Understanding what prayer is, is so essential in our faith journey. It is the very thing that connects us to the Father. Without a proper understanding we will never get the results we are desiring. When we don't know the purpose of something, it can be neglected and abused.

If Jesus had a prayer life, we most definitely should have one (Luke 6:12-13).

Jesus said in John 5," ...the son of man can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the father do." Jesus withdrew from the crowds to spend time with the father in prayer, gaining insight for his ministry. Jesus instructed us how not to pray and how to pray (Matthew 6:5-15).

Prayer is communication with God, conversation with Him, and intimacy and relationship with Him. There is so much more to prayer than just asking God to meet our daily needs.

The word of God instructs us to pray in the spirit at all times (Ephesians 6:18) and to pray without ceasing (1 Thessalonians 5:17-19). How do we follow God's word pray continually?

The prayer life of the believer is not meant or designed to be an allotted portion of time each day. Prayer is the way of life for the believer. Prayer is made up of giving thanks, worshiping, praising, loving on the Lord, and spending time with Him. Prayer is a two way conversation. There is a place for binding and loosing and for petitions and supplications; however, that all comes from relationship with Him and learning our authority as a children of God. Prayer is an amazing thing God gave his children to fellowship and communicate with Him.

At Prayer School, you will be equipped with truth that will encourage and empower your relationship with the Father and strengthen your prayer journey. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. Be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.

The Presence of God

Faith doesn't come from the mind; it comes from the heart. Yet a renewed mind enhances our faith through an understanding of the unseen. It finds it fuel in knowing ways of the Holy Spirit—how He moves. What happens to a person when God rests upon them? (Psalm 16:11) Sometimes we fail to reach our destiny because we insist on it happening where we are-within reason, with little effort involved on our end. We often cannot get to a new place in worship until we get into a new place in God.

Past, Present, and Future

Psalm 24:7-10 (NKJV)

The purpose of the lifting (prayer) is so the King can come. When He shows us what's coming, it's not so we will strategize and plan. great. He will do everything according to His promises for His victorious bride. When Jesus said there would be wars and rumors of ward, He wasn't giving us a promise. He was describing the conditions into which He was releasing His last days army of transformational people.

AWAKENING

The personal introduction to a divine opportunity; An invitation to receive impartation.

1 King 19:19-21

So he departed from there, and found Elisha the son of Shaphat, who was plowing with twelve yoke of oxen before him, and he was with the twelfth. Then Elijah passed by him and threw his mantle on him. And he left the oxen and ran after Elijah, and said, "Please let me kiss my father and my mother, and then I will follow you." Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent instead of a fish? Or if he asks for an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!"

ACCEPTANCE

- The totality of God's word
- Your position in Christ
- Your Intercessory position
- All prayer assignments
- The responsibility for understanding and using your authority
- The responsibility for development of your prayer life
- The impartations that come from the preached word, prophecy, and laying on of hands

ACCESS

The entrance into the divine realm, power, revelation, miracles.

Jer 33:3; 1 Kings 18:41-46: Acts 16: 25-34; Matt 14:22-33

We were made to live in and from God's realm, doing things that reflect Him.

ACTION

Prepare your mind for prayer

1 Peter 4:7

But the end of all things is at hand; therefore be serious and watchful in your prayers.

Pray: Father it's not your fault that I have received less than your best. I repent for dishonoring You through my ignorance and lack of faith because this has prohibited Your promises from becoming a reality in my life. Holy Spirit, teach me how to receive your best continually. Show me what is required to honor You, so Your purpose for my life will be fulfilled.

- Declarations (Scriptural promises, Faith statements, etc..)
- Employ the revelation gifts,
- Warfare praying (Warfare prayer means we possess the spiritual insight to discern the evil. Then use the power and authority to eliminate the evil. This includes using our prophetic words)
- Use delegated authority to gain divine control and supernatural answers.



James 5:17-18 TPT; John 11:38-44; Acts 12:1-17

- Authoritative prayer begins in Heaven and ends on earth.
- Authoritative prayer is anchored in the resurrection an ascension that gave us a new position in Christ and in the earth. (Praying downward is standing in our Heavenly position in Jesus using the authority in Him to overthrow all evil by mandating the Lord's will be done.)
- Authoritative prayer is not asking The Father to do, but us announcing to the Father that we are going to apply the authority of Jesus directly to the situation or circumstance.

John Wesley prayed, and revival came to England, sparing that nation the horrors of the French Revolution.

Jonathan Edwards prayed, and revival spread throughout the American colonies. History has been changed time after time because of prayer. I tell you, history could be changed again if people went to their knees in believing prayer."

Mobilization is a principle that was put into place at the very beginning of time. Adam was instructed by the Lord to give names to the animals. He was given Eve to be his helpmate. From the very beginning, there was mobilization.

The things of the sea had their place, and the animals on the land had their place. The trees and plant life each had their place. The garden was put in place for Adam, God personally mobilized the earth for Adam, and he was instructed to be fruitful and multiply. What we will learn in our discussion of mobilizing will be the foundational principles and base to establish us and give us sound footing for our journey in becoming people of prayer.

To discuss mobilization with wisdom and knowledge, you must understand first about the spirit of unity.

PSALMS 133:1

Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! It is like the precious oil upon the head, running down on the beard, The beard of Aaron, running down on the edge of his garments. It is like the dew of Hermon, descending upon the mountains of Zion; for there the LORD commanded the blessing

THE GREATEST MOBILIZER

Matthew 4: 8

One day as Jesus was walking along the shore of the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers - Simon, also called Peter, and Andrew - throwing a net into the water, for they fished for a living. Jesus called out to them, "Come, follow me, and I will show you how to fish for people!" And they left their nets at once and followed him. A little farther up the shore he saw two other brothers, James, and John, sitting in a boat with their father, Zebedee, repairing their nets. And he called them to come, too. They immediately followed him, leaving the boat and their father behind.

Before we mobilize people to witness about the good news, we must help them to see the wonder of the gospel.

To be mobilized and mobilize others, we first as believers must fall in love with who Jesus is, by understanding what He came to do.

- **He came to save** "The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am the foremost." 1 Timothy 1:15
- Reconcile mankind back to the Father ...that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

MOBILIZE | The 8 Prayer Watches

The Lord wants to hone us in on prayer in a most effective way.

New Revelation on Prayer is available to us.

- God has chosen this time to bring greater depth and discernment to His people so that we can pray, hear, and discern in a more precise way.
- He is setting us up for greater success.

Lamentations 2:19 (KJV)

Arise, cry out in the night: in the beginning of the watches pour out thine heart like water before the face of the Lord: lift up thy hands toward him for the life of thy young children, that faint for hunger in the top of every street.

A watch, as described in the Bible, refers to a specific time or moment of the day. We all have 24 hours in a day. Each hour belongs to a particular watch amongst the eight prayer watches in the Bible. According to Hebrew custom, each day begins in the evening, not in the morning, as it is in the western world.

FIRST PRAYER WATCH - 6:00pm - 9:00pm

SECOND PRAYER WATCH - 9:00pm - 12:00am

THIRD PRAYER WATCH - 12:00am - 3:00am

FOURTH PRAYER WATCH - 3:00am - 6:00am

FIFTH PRAYER WATCH - 6:00am - 9:00am

SIXTH PRAYER WATCH - 9:00am - 12:00pm

PRAY THE WORD | HEALING

Psalm 30:2 - O LORD my God, I cried out to You, And You healed me.

Psalm 91:10 No evil shall befall you, Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling;

James 5:15-16 – And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well, the Lord will raise him up. If he has sinned, he will be forgiven.

Proverbs 4:20-22 - My son, pay attention to my words; incline your ear to my sayings. Do not lose sight of them; keep them within your heart. For they are life to those who find them, and health to the whole body.

Psalm 41:3 – The LORD will strengthen him on his bed of illness; You will sustain him on his sickbed.

Proverbs 14:30 - A sound heart is life to the body, But envy is rottenness to the bones

Isaiah 53:4-5 -Surely He took on our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered Him stricken by God, struck down and afflicted. But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.

1 Peter 2:24-25 – ...Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness-by whose stripes you were healed.

Psalm 103:2-4 – Praise the Lord, 0 my soul, and forget not all His benefits-who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases.

3 John 1:2 – Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.

Acts 10:38 - how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.



PRAY THE WORD | PROTECTION

Psalm 91:9-10 - If you make the Most High your dwelling-even the Lord, who is my refuge-then no harm will befall you, no disaster will come near your tent

2 Thessalonians 3:3 – But the Lord is faithful, and He will strengthen and protect you from the evil one.

Psalm 34:7 – The Angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear Him and each of them He delivers.

Psalm 121:8 – The Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.

Psalm 91:1-4 – He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust, surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the perilous pestilence. He shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth shall be your shield and buckler.

Deuteronomy 31:6 - Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy God, he it is that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

Proverbs 30:5 - Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him.

PRAY THE WORD | PROSPERITY

Deuteronomy 8:18 – but thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day.

Philippians 4:19 – But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Malachi 3:10 – Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

3 John 2 – Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

2 Corinthians 9:8 – And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work:

Psalms 51:12 – Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.

Isaiah 61:7 – Instead of your shame there shall be a double portion; instead of dishonor they shall rejoice in their lot: therefore in their land they shall possess a double portion; they shall have everlasting joy.

2 Corinthians 5:17 – therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

Matthew 10:1 - Jesus summoned His twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal every kind of disease and every kind of sickness.

Mark 16:17 - And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues;

Romans 8:31 - What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?

2 Corinthians 10:4-5 - For the weapons of our warfare are not [a]carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, 5casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

Ephesians 1:19-21 - and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come.

PRAY THE WORD | FAITH

Hebrews 11:1 - Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Hebrews 11:6 - But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Jude 1:20 - But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit...

James 1:2-4 - Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. And let endurance have its perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

Hebrew 6:11-12 - And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence so as to realize the full assurance of hope until the end, 12so that you will not be sluggish, but imitators of those who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

Romans 10:17 - So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Galatians 5:6 - For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but faith working through love.

Ephesians 2:8-9 - For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; 9not as a result of works, so that no one may hoast.

Mark 9:23 - Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."

Matthew 9:29 - Then He touched their eyes, saying, "According to your faith let it be to you."



PRAY THE WORD | BOLDNESS

Proverbs 28:1 - The wicked flee when no one pursues, But the righteous are bold as a lion.

Acts 4:13 - Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.

Psalm 28:7 - The Lord is my light and my salvation. Whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life, of whom shall I be afraid?

Romans 8:31-32 - If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?

Hebrews 4:16 - Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

1 Corinthians 16:13 Be watchful, stand firm in the faith, act like men, be strong.

2 Corinthians 3:12 - Since we have such a hope, we are very bold.

2 Timothy 1:7-8 For God has not given us a Spirit of Fear, but of power and love and a sound mind. Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord.

Philippians 1:14 - and most of the brethren in the Lord, having become confident by my chains, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.

Romans 4:5 - However, to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the wicked, his faith is credited as righteousness.



PRAY THE WORD | ANSWERED PRAYER

2 Samuel 22:7 - In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried to my God: and he did hear my voice out of his temple, and my cry did enter into his ears.

Psalms 4:3 - But know that the LORD has set apart for Himself him who is godly; The LORD will hear when I call to Him.

Psalm 6:9 - The LORD has heard my supplication; The LORD will receive my prayer.

Psalms 10:17 - LORD, You have heard the desire of the humble; You will prepare their heart; You will cause Your ear to hear,

Psalm 50:14-15 - "Offer to God a sacrifice of thanksgiving and pay your vows to the Most High; Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I shall rescue you, and you will honor Me."

Psalm 102:17 - He shall regard the prayer of the destitute, And shall not despise their prayer.

James 5:16 - Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.

1 Peter 3:12 - For the eyes of the LORD are on the righteous, And His ears are open to their prayers; But the face of the LORD is against those who do evil."

1 John 5:14-15 - Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

Mark 11:24 - Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.



PRAY THE WORD | FAVOR

Psalm 5:12 - For You, O LORD, will bless the righteous; With favor You will surround him as with a shield.

Psalms 41:11 - By this I know that You are well pleased with me, Because my enemy does not triumph over me.

Proverbs 3:3-4 - Do not let kindness and truth leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart. So you will find favor and good repute in the sight of God and man.

Proverbs 12:2 - A good man will obtain favor from the LORD, But He will condemn a man who devises evil.

Proverbs 13:15 - Good understanding gains favor, But the way of the unfaithful is hard.

VICTORY

1 Corinthians 15:57 - But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Psalm 60:12 - Through God we will do valiantly, For it is He who shall tread down our enemies.

Psalm 92:4 - For You, LORD, have made me glad through Your work; I will triumph in the works of Your hands.

1 John 4:4 - You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

1 John 5:4 - For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world— our faith.

PRAY THE WORD | REDEMPTION

Psalm 71:23 - My lips shall greatly rejoice when I sing to You, And my soul, which You have redeemed.

Psalms 107:2 - Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, Whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy,

Lamentations 3:58 - 0 Lord, You have pleaded the case for my soul; You have redeemed my life.

1 Peter 1:18-19 - knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, 19but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ.

Galatians 3:13-14 - Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, "CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO HANGS ON A TREE"— 14in order that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we would receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

RIGHTEOUSNESS

Genesis 15:6 - And he believed in the LORD, and He accounted it to him for righteousness.

Psalm 34:15 - The eyes of the LORD are on the righteous, And His ears are open to their cry.

Psalm 37:15,25 - For the arms of the wicked will be broken, But the LORD sustains the righteous. I have been young and now I am old, Yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken or his descendants begging bread.

2 Corinthians 5:21 - For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

1 John 2:29 - If you know that He is righteous, you know that everyone who practices righteousness is born of Him.
