QUESTIONS

- What did John mean when he said he was not worthy to untie Jesus' sandals?
- Why do you think John was so shocked that Jesus wanted to be baptized by him?
- What did God say when Jesus came out of the water?
- Read Luke 3:21. Why do you think Jesus chose to get baptized even though he had no sin?
- What is some "noise" you can cancel out in your life so you can hear God's voice better?
- Imagine God sitting with us right now. What do you think God would say to you?
- What are some things you know God is saying to you through the Bible or through others?
