

Discussion Questions – Isaiah 2:1-4:6

Isaiah 2:1-5 – What does coming to house of the Lord look like for a Christian? What is required of us to do this?

How would we know if someone were judging us fairly? What would a fair judgement look like? What would it cost us, what would it cost the other?

What would it take to be able to live in a place of total peace with no fear of the people around you? What must happen for this to work?

Isaiah 2:6-22 – What do the “nations” take pride in? What does the church take pride in? What will allow us to stand in the coming Day of the Lord? Take a look specifically at v.22, who do we take this verse?

Isaiah 3:1-4:1 – This gives us a picture of what the judgment of God looks like when live in rebellion to God. We go through a wilderness time when survival is the key. Why do we have wilderness times in our lives? What is God showing us in our wilderness times? What is the point of God’s judgment?

Isaiah 4:2-6 – What should we take pride according to this passage? Why? God’s presence is back among the people. What is required for this to occur?
