I. The Voice Before the Fire

- A. A word of promise about the coming fire (Matthew 3:11) "I baptize you with water for repentance, but he who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. <u>He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire</u>."
- B. A word of patience about the coming fire (Luke 24:46-49) "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, [47] and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. [48] You are witnesses of these things. [49] And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. But stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."

II. The Fire Before the Voice

- A. God's fire over a people (Exodus 19:18) "Now Mount Sinai was wrapped in smoke <u>because the LORD</u> <u>had descended on it in fire</u>. The smoke of it went up like the smoke of a kiln, and the whole mountain trembled greatly."
- B. God's fire surrounding a person (Exodus 24:15-18) "Then Moses went up on the mountain, and the cloud covered the mountain. [16] The glory of the LORD dwelt on Mount Sinai, and <u>the cloud covered</u> it six days. And on the seventh day he called to Moses out of the midst of the cloud. [17] Now the appearance of the glory of the LORD was like a devouring fire on the top of the mountain in the sight of the people of Israel. [18] Moses entered the cloud and went up on the mountain. And Moses was on the mountain forty days and forty nights."
