1. A Woman with a Desperate Heart (22)

- a. She was burdened "...a Canaanite woman from that region came out and was crying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord..."
- b. She was borrowing "...Son of David..." As a Gentile she had no ability to engage Him by this Jewish title
- c. She was broken "...my daughter is severely oppressed by a demon."

2. A Woman with a Determined Heart (23-24)

- a. She faced the test of silence (23a) "But He did not answer her a word..."
- b. She faced the test of fear (23b) "And His disciples came and begged him, saying, "Send her away, for she is crying out after us."
- c. She faced the test of hopelessness (24) "He answered, I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel."

Jesus did not rush to relieve her fear and trouble. He responded in a way that would prove the degree of her desire for Him.

3. A Woman with a Discerning Heart (25-27)

- a. She understood there were no other options (25) "But she came and knelt before Him, saying, Lord, help me."
- b. She understood there was no entitlement (26) "It is not right to take the children's bread and throw it to the dogs."

c. She understood she had nothing to bargain with (27) - "Yes, Lord, yet even the dogs eat the crumbs that fall from their masters' table."

4. A Woman with a Displayed Heart (28)

- a. Her faith is put on display (28a) "O woman, great is your faith!"
 - i. Her faith was great due to what she lacked National covenants, individual promises, exposure to Truth
 - ii. Her faith was great due to what she possessed Insight, humbling, resiliency, boldness, expectation
- b. Her favor is put on display "...Be it done for you as you desire..."
- c. Her fulfillment is put on display " ... And her daughter was healed instantly."
