I. Where Our Focus Rests (9)

"Therefore God has highly exalted Him and bestowed on Him the name that is above every name..."

II. Where Our Will Bows in Honor (10)

"So that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth..."

Revelation 5:11-14 - "Then I looked, and I heard around the throne and the living creatures and the elders the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands, 12 saying with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!" 13 And I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and in the sea, and all that is in them, saying, "To Him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and might forever and ever!" 14 And the four living creatures said, "Amen!" and the elders fell down and worshiped."

III. What Our Mouths & Lives Proclaim (11)

"...and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."

Jesus is referred to as Lord 618 times, but only 15 times is he referred to as Savior. He is referred to as the Christ 543 times

<u>Romans 10:9-10</u> - "If you confess with your mouth that <u>Jesus is Lord</u> and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved."

2 Corinthians 4:5 - "For what we proclaim is not ourselves, but <u>Jesus Christ as Lord</u>, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake."

1 Peter 3:15 - "In your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy..."

<u>Colossians 2:6-7</u> - "Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving."

Romans 14:7-9 - "For none of us lives to himself, and none of us dies to himself. 8 For if we live, we live to the Lord, and if we die, we die to the Lord. So then, whether we live or whether we die, we are the Lord's. 9 For to this end Christ died and lived again, that He might be Lord both of the dead and of the living."

Luke 6:46 - "Why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and not do what I tell you?"

2 Thessalonians 1:6-12 - "God considers it just to repay with affliction those who afflict you, 7 and to grant relief to you who are afflicted as well as to us, when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels 8 in flaming fire, inflicting vengeance on those who do not know God and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. 9 They will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His might, 10 when He comes on that day to be glorified in His saints, and to be marveled at among all who have believed, because our testimony to you was believed. 11 To this end we always pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling and may fulfill every resolve for good and every work of faith by His power, 12 so that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ."
