#### I. A Peaceful Portion (1-2)

# 15 different Hebrew words for sin in OT

- A. God's forgiveness (1a) "Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven" Rebellion
- B. God's faithfulness (1b) "...<u>whose sin is covered</u>..." Failure
- C. God's freedom (2) "Blessed is the man against whom the LORD counts no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit..."

#### II. A Problematic Path (3-4)

- A. David had been defiant (3a) "When I kept silence my bones waxed wasted away..." No confession, no repentance
- B. David had been disturbed (3b) "...through my groaning all day long..." No peace, constant agony
- C. David had been disciplined (4a) "For day and night Your hand was heavy upon me..."
- D. David had been dry (4b) "...my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer."

# III. A Purifying Pardon (5)

- A. David opened his mouth "I acknowledged my sin to You..."
- B. David opened his heart "... and I did not cover my iniquity..."
- C. David opened his mind "...<u>I will confess my transgressions</u> to the Lord..." Confess means 'to agree with'
- D. God closed His book "...you forgave the iniquity of my sin..." David was not open to any charges!

# IV. A Prevailing Prayer (6-7)

- A. God is near, talk to Him (6) "Therefore let everyone who is godly offer prayer to you at a time when you may be found; surely in great waters, they shall not reach him."
- B. God's arms are open, run to Him (7a) "You are a hiding place for me; you preserve me from trouble"
- C. God's protection is available, rest in Him (7b) "You surround me with shouts of deliverance."

#### V. A Pathway to Purity (8-11) {God speaks to David here}

- A. Step 1: Be teachable (8) "Lwill instruct you & teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my eye upon you..."
- B. **Step 2**: Be obedient (9) "Be not like a horse or a mule, without understanding, which must be curbed with bit and bridle, or it will not stay near you."
- D. Step 4: Be aware (10) "Many are the sorrows of the wicked, but steadfast love surrounds the one who trusts in the LORD."
- E. Step 5Be surrendered (11) "Be glad in the LORD, and rejoice, O righteous, and shout for joy, all you upright in heart!
