I. The Reality of Their Bondage (10)

"Some sat in darkness and in the shadow of death, prisoners in affliction and in irons..."

- II. The Reason for Their Bondage (11-12)
  - A. A rebellious heart (11a) "...for they had rebelled against the words of God..." Contempt for God's word
  - B. A prideful heart (11b) "...and spurned the counsel of the Most High." Contempt for God's ways
  - C. A sobered heart (12) "So He bowed their hearts down with hard labor; they fell down, with none to help."
- III. The Response in Their Bondage (13)

"Then they cried to the LORD in their trouble, and He delivered them from their distress."

IV. The Release from Their Bondage (13b-16)

- A. Redeemed by grace & mercy (14) "He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and burst their bonds apart."
- B. Renewed in gratitude & joy (15) "Let them thank the LORD for His steadfast love, for His wondrous works to the children of man!"
- C. Released in freedom & possibility (16) "For He shatters the doors of bronze and cuts in two the bars of iron."
