

I. Everlasting Worship Is Employed (15-17)

A. What we are all longing to hear (15) - “Then the seventh angel blew his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, “The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever.””

B. What we are all going to do (16) - “And the twenty-four elders who sit on their thrones before God fell on their faces and worshiped God...”

C. What we are all going to shout (17) - “We give thanks to You, Lord God Almighty, “We give thanks to You, Lord God Almighty, who is and who was, for You have taken Your great power and begun to reign.””

II. Earth’s Wicked Are Destroyed (18)

A. We will worship Him for His wrath (18a) - “The nations raged, but Your wrath came, and the time for the dead to be judged...”

B. We will worship Him for His generosity (18b) - “...and for rewarding Your servants, the prophets and saints, and those who fear Your name, both small and great...”

C. We will worship Him for His victory (18c) - “...and for destroying the destroyers of the earth.”

III. Eternal Witness Enjoyed (19)

A. The witness of God’s presence (19a) - “Then God’s temple in heaven was opened...”

B. The witness of God’s faithfulness (19b) - “...and the ark of His covenant was seen within His temple.”

C. The witness of God’s power (19c) - “There were flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder, an earthquake, and heavy hail.”
