1 John 4:1-6 Preached 4/29/15 Meadow Baptist Church

1. A Call For Spiritual Discernment (1)

- a. John's warning "Beloved, do not believe every spirit..."
- b. John's wisdom "...but test the spirits, to see whether they are from God..."
- c. John's witness "...for many false prophets have gone out into the world."

2. A Commitment to Solid Doctrine (2-3)

- a. Dogmatic teaching (2a) "By this you know the Spirit of God..."
- b. Defining teaching (2b) "...every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God..."
- c. Disqualifying teaching (3a) "and every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God."
- d. Destructive teaching (3b) "...this is the spirit of the antichrist, which you heard was coming and now is in the world already."

1 Timothy 4:1 - "Now the Spirit expressly says that in later times some will depart from the faith by devoting themselves to deceitful spirits and teachings of demons."

3. A Clearly Seen Distinction (4-6)

- a. God's people (4)
 - i. We are overcomers "Little children, you are from God and have overcome them..."
 - ii. We are owned "...for He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world."
- b. Godless people (5)
 - i. Their foundation "They are from the world..."
 - ii. Their focus "...therefore they speak from the world..."
 - iii. Their following "...and the world listens to them."
- c. Guided people (6) "... By this we know the Spirit of truth and the spirit of error."
 - i. Those guided by divine wisdom "We are from God. Whoever knows God listens to us..."
 - ii. Those guided by destructive wisdom "...whoever is not from God does not listen to us."
