- I. We Wait on God to Establish Our Names (1-2)
 - A. A commitment to unity under David (1) "Then all the tribes of Israel came to David at Hebron and said, "Behold, we are your bone and flesh."
 - B. An affirming clarity about David (2a) "In times past, when Saul was king over us, <u>it was you who</u> led out and brought in Israel."
 - C. An embracing of destiny for David (2b) "And <u>the Lord said to you, You shall be shepherd</u> of my people Israel, and <u>you shall be prince</u> over Israel.""
- II. We Hope in God for Promised Breakthrough (3-5)
 - A. God will handle your opposition (3) "So <u>all the elders of Israel came to the king at Hebron</u>, and King David made a covenant with them at Hebron before the Lord, and <u>they anointed David king over</u> <u>Israel</u>."
 - B. God will teach you to trust His timing (4) "David was thirty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned forty years."
 - C. Breakthrough may come incrementally (5) "At Hebron <u>he reigned over Judah seven years and six</u> <u>months</u>, and at Jerusalem he reigned over all Israel and Judah thirty-three years."
- III. We Learn to Treasure the Presence of God (10-12)
 - A. God's presence is God's favor (10) "And <u>David became greater and greater</u>, for <u>the Lord</u>, the God of hosts, <u>was with him</u>."
 - B. God's presence will often birth favor with man (11) "And Hiram king of Tyre sent messengers to David, and cedar trees, also carpenters and masons who built David a house."
 - C. God presence blesses others through us (12) "And <u>David knew that the Lord had established him</u> king over Israel, and that <u>He had exalted his kingdom for the sake of His people Israel</u>."
