## Preached in part #1

## I. The Constant Heart-Posture of the Christian (10-14)

"<u>That I may know Him</u> and the power of <u>His</u> resurrection, and may share <u>His</u> sufferings, <u>becoming like Him</u> in <u>His</u> death, 11 that by any means possible I may attain the resurrection from the dead. <u>Not that I have already obtained</u> <u>this or am already perfect, but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own</u>. 13 Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But <u>one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind</u> and <u>straining forward</u> to what lies ahead, 14 I <u>press on</u> toward the goal for <u>the prize</u> of the <u>upward call</u> of God in Christ Jesus."

## II. The Determined Mindset of the Christian (15-16)

"Let those of us <u>who are mature think this way</u> and <u>if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal that also to</u> <u>you</u>. Only let us <u>hold true to what we have attained</u>."

I. The Potential Leaders of the Christian (17-19)

A. Those with an authentic testimony (17) - "Brothers, join in imitating me, and keep your eyes on those who walk according to the example you have in us."

B. Those with an adverse testimony (18-19) - "For many, of whom I have often told you and now tell you even with tears, <u>walk as enemies of the cross of Christ</u>. 19 <u>Their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things</u>."

- **II.** The Unfolding Glory for the Christian (20-21)
  - A. A present belonging (20a) "But our citizenship is in heaven..."
  - B. A promised return (20b) "...and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ..."

C. A perfect body (21) - "Who will <u>transform our lowly body to be like His glorious body</u> by the power that enables him even to subject all things to Himself."
