## "The Uncontainable New"

### 1. What the Religious Spirit Demands (33)

*"And they said to Him, "The disciples of John fast often and offer prayers, and so do the disciples of the Pharisees, but Yours eat and drink."*

- a. You must always be solemn to be spiritual - "And they said to Him, The disciples of John fast often and offer prayers..."
- b. You must not break tradition to be spiritual - "...and so do the disciples of the Pharisees..."
- c. You cannot be jubilant and be spiritual - "...but yours eat and drink."

### 2. What the Renewing Savior Declares (34-38)

*"And Jesus said to them, "Can you make wedding guests fast while the bridegroom is with them? 35 The days will come when the bridegroom is taken away from them, and then they will fast in those days." 36 He also told them a parable: "No one tears a piece from a new garment and puts it on an old garment. If he does, he will tear the new, and the piece from the new will not match the old. 37 And no one puts new wine into old wineskins. If he does, the new wine will burst the skins and it will be spilled, and the skins will be destroyed. 38 But new wine must be put into fresh wineskins."*

- a. We are not held down people (34-35) - "And Jesus said to them, "Can you make wedding guests fast while the bridegroom is with them? The days will come when the bridegroom is taken away from them, and then they will fast in those days."
- b. We are not patched up people (36) - "He also told them a parable: "No one tears a piece from a new garment and puts it on an old garment. If he does, he will tear the new, and the piece from the new will not match the old."

- c. We are not worn out people (37) - "And no one puts new wine into old wineskins. If he does, the new wine will burst the skins and it will be spilled, and the skins will be destroyed."
- d. We are completely renewed people (38) - "But new wine must be put into fresh wineskins."

### 3. What the Redeemed Saints Must Decide (39)

*"And no one after drinking old wine desires new, for he says, 'The old is good.'"*

- a. A familiar experience with the lesser - "And no one after drinking old wine..."
- b. A proud refusal of the better - "And no one...desires new..."
- c. An ongoing residence in the rut - "...for he says, The old is good."
