## I. The Simplicity Of Success (11-15)

- A. Success has been revealed (11) "For this commandment that I command you today is not too hard for you, neither is it far off."
- B. Success is attainable (12-14) "It is not in heaven, that you should say, "Who will ascend to heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?" 13 Neither is it beyond the sea, that you should say, "Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?" 14 But the word is very near you. It is in your mouth and in your heart, so that you can do it."
- C. Success is up to you (15) "See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil."

## II. The Secret Of Success (16)

- A. It involves your will "If you obey the commandments of the Lord your God that I command you today..."
- B. It involves your priorities "...by loving the Lord your God..."
- C. It involves your actions "...by <u>walking in His ways</u>, and by <u>keeping His commandments</u> and His statutes and His rules..."
- D. It involves your confidence "...then you shall live and multiply, and the Lord your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it."

## III. The Slaying Of Success (17-18)

- A. A warning about our hearts (17a) "But if your heart turns away, and you will not hear..."
- B. A warning about our walks (17b) "...but are drawn away to worship other gods and serve them..."
- C. A warning about our losses (18) I declare to you today, that you shall surely perish. You shall not live long in the land that you are going over the Jordan to enter and possess."

## IV. The Steps Of Success (19-20)

- A. Choose (19) "I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Therefore choose life, that you and your offspring may live..."
- B. Devote (20a) "...loving the Lord your God..."
- C. Trust (20b) "...obeying his voice and holding fast to Him..."
- D. Understand (20c) "...for He is your life and length of days..."
- E. Receive (20d) "...that you may dwell in the land that the Lord swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them."
