

I. His Glory Is Forever (13a)

Dominance, military strength, legal authority

“Your Kingdom is an everlasting Kingdom, and Your dominion endures throughout all generations.”

Everything that God does in His relationship with humanity is pointing towards the ushering in of an everlasting Kingdom. His dominion (or rule) will cover the cosmos and His glory will be the permanent central theme.

II. He Is Perfectly Trustworthy (13b) (might need to mention textual variant here)

“The LORD is faithful in all His words and kind in all His works.”

“Once have I sworn by my holiness that I will not lie...” - Psalm 89:35

“God is not man, that he should lie, or a son of man, that he should change his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it?” - Numbers 23:19

“If we are faithless, He remains faithful, for He cannot deny Himself.” - 2 Timothy 2:13

Everything God says, He will do. Everything He does for us is anchored in His kindness.

III. His Compassion Is Constant (14)

“The LORD upholds all who are falling and raises up all who are bowed down.”

Upholds - to be an ally, to support, to help, to lay a hand upon, to surround

God never promises that we will not be bent, broken or bruised. He promises to meet us in the midst of those realities.

IV. He Provides All That is Needed (15)

“The eyes of all look to You, and You give them their food in due season.”

“Look” - to look at something with expectation and hope

“Due season” - wisdom teaches us that we must learn to discern the seasons and expect accordingly. Not every season is harvest. We must reclaim the discipline of waiting in seasons of stillness while expecting and hoping toward the coming breakthrough.

V. He Fully Satisfies Those Who Seek Him (16)

“You open your hand; You satisfy the desire of every living thing.”

“desire” - joy, pleasure, longing, expectation for favor
