TALK #1: CREATING A CULTURE OF RELENTLESS DISCIPLESHIP

Vision of making disciples by developing the Create, Capture, Sustain mindset within men.

Create (Value)

Environment in their church where the Holy Spirit inspires men to engage in lifeon-life discipleship

- Opportunities for men to get involved
- Give men something they find valuable
- Personal initiative of men going after other men

Think about how you can identify allies—men who will go after other men, who will own the idea of personally inviting other men to be a part of that initiative.

Capture (Momentum)

- Give men believable next steps
- Short-term believable opportunity that you can put in front of a man in the context of a relationship
- Have one event and have men who attend various ministries talk about
- those ministries with the men who are disconnected

• On-site commitment for them (men in the crowd personally inviting those men)


Sustain (Change)

• Every interaction our church is having with any man is Men's ministry. part of our men's discipleship process.

• Drive men towards the most effective disciple- making ministries in our church

• Get behind the things that are working already

• Take advantage of where God is already working in your church

- 3. Don't Violate the Process
 - 1st Base: Acquaintances "Accept One Another"
 - -Context (Form)
 - Parameters
 - Confidentiality
 - 2nd Base: Friends "Encourage One Another"
 - -Conflict (Storm)
 - Rules of engagement
 - Life crisis or personality conflicts

Disciples who make dDisciples

- 3rd Base: Brothers "Exhort One Another"
 - -Covenant (Norm)
 - Accountability
 - You cannot start an accountability group; you can only become one
 - Permission & trust



TALK #4: BUILDING YOUR LEADERSHIP TEAM

MIKE YOUNG - RICHMOND, VA

Men's Discipleship Is a Team Sport - Why?

Throughout the Bible, ministry is modeled to us in the context of community and teams.

Genesis 1:26 "Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion..."

Old Testament: Moses, Aaron and Hur, Jonathan and his armor bearer, David's mighty men, Moses and the tribal judges

New Testament: Jesus had a team: disciples were sent out in pairs: Peter and John, Paul and Barnabas, Paul and Silas, Paul and Timothy

Focus on Jethro and Moses (Exodus 18)

Jesus Was the Master of Leadership Development! Four Key Lessons:

1. Alone is exhausting and dangerous

- a. Blind spots are real.
- b. Every man is a finite resource.

2. Diversity of skills and people matter

a. What skills do you need or desire for your leadership team?b. What groups of men are you trying to reach? Are they represented in leadership?

c. Use a matrix to help with your recruitment and selection.

3. Engage more men

a. Strategic planning and thinking will help you invite men from the 'fringe' to join your team.

b. Follow Jesus' model. Look for men with undeveloped talent and invest in them.

c. You may need to start with a list of ALL the men who would call your church home.

4. Develop new leaders

a. Men's ministry initiatives provide great training ground for young men or reluctant men to learn and sharpen leadership skills.b. Leverage a key leader who others want to emulate. Release him from other obligations and give him one job... Reproduce yourself. Grow other men who are capable of leading!

The A-Team Model: Hannibal, Murdock, B. A., Faceman

The Manger Build: Prayer Guy, Logistics Guy, Communications Guy, Construction Guy, A Face Man

Men's Retreat: Prayer Guy, Registration Guy, Promotion Guy, Food Guy, Activities Guy

Summer is for Team Development: Begin planning now for a fall men's campaign... Catalytic Event> Capture Momentum> Sustain Change. Start by developing a team to pray, plan, prepare and execute the strategy!

TALK #5: HELPING MEN TO OVERCOME TRAPS

"Accountability: being subject to the obligation to report, explain, or justify something; being responsible or answerable to someone."

Importance of Accountability Scripture:

Proverbs 11:14 "Where there is no guidance, the people fall, but in abundance of counselors there is victory."

Proverbs 9:8-9 "Reprove a wise man, and he will love you. Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be still wiser, Teach a righteous man, and he will increase His learning."

Proverbs 12:1 "Whoever loves discipline loves knowledge, but he who hates reproof is stupid."

Proverbs 27:17 "Iron sharpens iron, so one man sharpens another."

Proverbs 27:6 "Faithful are the wounds of a friend, but deceitful are the kisses of an enemy."

Hebrews 3:13 "But encourage one another day after day, as long as it is still called 'Today,' lest any one of you be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin."

James 5:16 "Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another, so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much."

Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 "Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their work. If one falls down, his friend can help him up. But pity the man who falls and has no one to help him up!" (NLT: The man who is alone is in real TROUBLE).

Five Biblical Mandates For Accountability: Why Should I Be Accountable?

- 1. Satan, our enemy, loves to see us STUMBLE (1 Peter 5:8-9)
- 2. The world is closely WATCHING us (Ephesians 5:16)

3. To remain RIGHT with the Lord (Ephesians 2:4-10)

- 4. It ENCOURAGES other believers and ourselves (Hebrews 10:24)
- 5. JUDGMENT is coming (Ecclesiastes 12:14)

Six Benefits Of Being Accountable: Guaranteed!

- 1. You will GROW in your Christian walk
- 2. You will gain DEEPER friendships
- 3. You will have a greater UNDERSTANDING
- 4. You will experience PEACE
- 5. You will live by your PRIORITIES
- 6. You will develop a SUPPORT system

TALK #6: MINISTRY TO MEN: IS IT WORTH IT?

KRIS DOLBERRY - NASHVILLE, TN

Matthew 16:13-18

13 When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea Philippi, He asked His disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?"

14 And they said, "Some say John the Baptist; others, Elijah; still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets."

15 "But you," He asked them, "who do you say that I am?"

16 Simon Peter answered, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God!" 17 And Jesus responded, "Simon son of Jonah, you are blessed because

flesh and blood did not reveal this to you, but My Father in heaven.

18 It should be: And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of hell will not prevail against it."

Jesus Gives Peter Two Things:

1. Jesus gave Peter a PURPOSE.

Genesis 3:15 – "I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel."

Church (Ekklesia): A gathering. Called out ones. Often used as a military term. An army.

- Peter, I want you to lead my army (Church)

Acts 1:8 - "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria,

and to the end of the earth."

- Peter living in the purpose that God created him for
- Delivers famous sermon and thousands come to faith in Christ
- In that moment Jesus built his church through Peter

2. Jesus gave Peter a PROMISE.

Matthew 16:18 – "And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it."

- Nothing will stop the Church!

• "... the gates of hell will not prevail against it."

3. How is Jesus' promise to Peter encouraging to you?






