

Thanksgiving Box Giveaway

In conjunction with the Christian Love Pantry, FBC will again be providing food boxes consisting of 40 lbs of dry goods, a turkey and produce to 175 qualifying St. Clair County households. The boxes will be given out at First Baptist on Saturday, November 22, from 9-10 am.

You can help by purchasing a box for one of these families. Cost: \$25/Box

Make checks payable to FBC and designate it for "Food Boxes". **Volunteers are needed** ...

On **Friday November 21st**, we will pack boxes at the Community Food Bank in Birmingham. We will report to the Food Bank at 8:45am, start packing at 9, and be done packing all 350 boxes before 11am. On **Saturday Nov. 22nd**, volunteers are needed to move, sort and pass out food. These volunteers should report at 8am. We will also need traffic directors and people willing to pray with those waiting in line beginning at 7:30am as clients arrive at the church for the giveaway. We will be finished before 11am.

Please help us support the Christian Love Pantry as they provide emergency food to families in St. Clair County affected by the government shut down. Donations of nonperishable items (dry goods and canned goods) that are in-date are appreciated. The list below are some suggested items:

Canned Meats (Tuna, Vienna Sausage, Spam, etc.), Ketchup, Mayonnaise and Mustard, Corn Meal, Canned Corn, Dry Milk, Flour, Grits. Jelly, Macaroni & Cheese, Oatmeal, Pork & Beans, Pudding Cups, Ramen Noodles, Rice, Skillet Dinners, and Peanut Butter.

Please drop the items off at the church in the boxes provided in the MPR, the Sanctuary and the Adult Sunday School hallway or bring them by the church office during the week. They may also be dropped off at the Christian Love Pantry Monday thru Wednesday or Friday between 9am and Noon.

Monetary donations are always welcome. Because the Pantry can purchase food at a very deep discount from the Community Food Bank, the dollars go a long way. Checks may be mailed to Christian Love Pantry, 205 Edwin Holladay Place, #105, Pell City, AL 35125.
