



Alabama Baptist Foundation Scholarship

The Baptist Foundation of Alabama manages 100+ scholarship funds for students pursuing undergraduate, graduate, and doctoral degrees. Students who meet the criteria for the funds are eligible for scholarship awards. In order to apply for a scholarship with The Baptist Foundation of Alabama, the following qualifications and requirements must be met:

- Applicant is to be a bona fide resident of the State of Alabama.
- Applicant is to be a member in good standing of a Southern Baptist Church cooperating with the Alabama Baptist State Convention. (Seminary applicant is to be a member of a Southern Baptist church cooperating with the Southern Baptist Convention.)
- Applicant is to be classified as a full-time student according to the school's current catalog. (Exceptions may be granted in certain special situations.)
- Applicant must have and maintain a 2.0 GPA.

The Baptist Foundation of Alabama awards scholarships on an annual basis. Scholarships are not renewable. Students must reapply each year to be eligible. Go to tbfa.org/scholarships to apply. Deadline to apply for the 2026/2027 academic year is February 28.
