

- The Olivet Discourse Led by Ed Glasscock. The Olivet Discourse is a significant passage in the Synoptic Gospels (Matthew 24-25, Mark 13, and Luke 21) where Jesus discusses future events. The discourse is often interpreted as a warning and a call to be prepared for what is to come. Location: Fellowship Hall. No book cost - bring your Bible.
