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DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

READ JOHN 1:35-2:25 TOGETHER.

WHAT STOOD OUT TO YOU THIS WEEK IN YOUR TEAM WITH THE ACCOUNT OF JOHN?

THE PASSAGE DESCRIBES JESUS ASKING HIS NEW FOLLOWERS, "WHAT DO YOU WANT? WHAT ARE YOU SEEKING?" HOW DOES THIS QUESTION RESONATE WITH YOUR OWN SPIRITUAL JOURNEY?

WHAT ARE YOU SEEKING IN YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD, AND HOW DOES THAT SHAPE YOUR IDENTITY AND ACTIONS?

IN JOHN 1:46-47 WE SEE JESUS USING HUMOR WHEN INTERACTING WITH NATHANAEL, HIS DISCIPLE, AND IN JOHN 2:1 WE GET A PICTURE OF JESUS ATTENDING A WEDDING AND BEING WELCOMED TO THE PARTY.

KNOWING THAT JESUS HAD HUMOR AND FUN, HOW DOES THIS CHANGE HOW YOU APPROACH OR INTERACT WITH HIM?

DO YOU ALLOW YOURSELF TIME TO LAUGH WITH AND ENJOY JESUS?

JESUS CHANGED SIMON'S NAME TO PETER, SIGNALING A NEW IDENTITY ALIGNED WITH HIS SPIRITUAL TRANSFORMATION. SHARE A PERSONAL EXPERIENCE WHERE YOU FELT A SHIFT IN IDENTITY OR PURPOSE AFTER AN ENCOUNTER OR REALIZATION IN YOUR FAITH.

THE MESSAGE EMPHASIZES THAT OUR ACTIONS REFLECT OUR UNDERSTANDING OF GOD TO OTHERS.

HOW CAN YOU MORE EFFECTIVELY REFLECT CHRIST'S LOVE AND TRUTH IN YOUR DAILY INTERACTIONS?

IS THERE AN ENVIRONMENT OR AREA OF YOUR LIFE YOU FEEL CALLED TO REFLECT CHRIST WELL?

IS THERE SOMEONE IN YOUR LIFE WHO REFLECTS CHRIST WELL?

ANDREW IMMEDIATELY SHARES HIS DISCOVERY OF THE MESSIAH WITH HIS BROTHER SIMON PETER (JOHN 1:40). REFLECT ON A TIME WHEN YOU SHARED SOMETHING SIGNIFICANT ABOUT YOUR FAITH WITH SOMEONE ELSE AND WHAT WAS THE OUTCOME?
