

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Read John 5 together.

Jesus emphasizes the importance of following the example set by the Father, saying, "the Son can do nothing by himself; he can only do what he sees his Father doing" (John 5:19). How can we apply this principle in our own lives? Are there areas where we struggle to relinquish control and trust in God's guidance?

What does the miracle of Jesus healing the invalid tell us about Jesus' priorities and his power? How does this influence our understanding of God's will and timing in our lives, especially in situations that seem unchanging?

Pastor Chris emphasized that Jesus found His value not in His own accomplishments or the approval of others, but in obedience to God and His plan. How does this perspective challenge the way we typically assess our own worth? Discuss ways we can shift from seeking validation through achievements to finding our true value in our relationship with God and obedience to His commands.

Discuss how humility impacts our relationship with God and with others. Can you share personal experiences where humility led to deeper spiritual growth or community connection?

can we discern His calling in our daily lives and what are practical steps we can take to be more obedient to His will?
