Honor means to	
Positional Value (Honor): Honor or Value is given simply because of and usually directed to an authority.  Romans 14:11	
<b>Relational Value (Honor):</b> Relational value is based on the valuing of each person in the relationship and the desire to grow in intimacy and trust.	
Exodus 20:1-17	
Matthew 22:36-39 (NASB95) 36 "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" 37 And He said to him, "'YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND.' 38 This is the great and foremost commandment. 39 The second is like it, 'YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.' 40 On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets."
