Small Group Questions  
Week of August 16, 2020

### **Icebreaker:**

1. *Tell us about one of your more memorable dreams: Who was in it? What happened?*
2. *What is one way you have offered hope to someone who is discouraged?*

### **Discussion Questions:**

1. Review: Zechariah prophesied after God's people returned to Jerusalem after being exiled for 70 years. How is that background important for understanding Zechariah's message?
2. In verse 1:3, why did God still call them to return to Him even though they had already returned to Jerusalem?
3. Read Zechariah 7:2-10; Micah 6:6-8 & John 4:21-24. Scripture is clear that worship is of utmost importance to God. What kind of worship does God want from us?
  - What kind of worship does he *not* want?
4. Read Zechariah 2:10-11 & 8:3-8. God promises to live (or dwell) among them in the restored Jerusalem. How might that promise have given hope to the people of that time?
  - Read Revelation 21:1-3. How might this similar promise have given hope to the early church in a time of persecution?
  - How might these promises give us hope today?
5. Zechariah helps the people of his time view their unfinished work in light of God's eternal work. Right now, where do you need that reminder in your own life?
