Icebreaker: Did you have a nickname growing up and what was it? If you could nickname yourself, what would it be?

Discussion Questions:

1. Reread John 20:19-29.

Why is it unfair to nickname Thomas "The Doubter"?

2. Reread James 1:5-8.

What is the significance of the context to the topic of doubt?

Did this help you understand what James is speaking to or did it confuse you more about doubt?

Can you think of any honest doubters/seekers in the Bible?

3. How was Thomas' experience something for us all?

Which of the three things Thomas experienced (we all have questions, Jesus knows what they are, and Jesus knows the difficulty of faith) stood out or spoke to you the most?

- 4. Did you have a question of God that you searched out and found an answer to? What was the question and the answer?
- 5. Is there a question you have of God which you have reached the point of not being able to be answered or known in full?
- 6. Did you try writing out what you know that you know? How was that experience for you?

What are some "we know that we know" your group has about faith, God, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, etc.?
