(Acts 4:13 reveals the change others observed about Peter and the disciples following the resurrection.)

How does this fact support the proof of the resurrection?

4. Why do you think the facts of the resurrection don't convince more people about Jesus?

5. Would you say faith comes: easy for you? A little bit of a struggle for you? A lot of struggle for you?

Is there any one thing about the resurrection that affirms your faith?

Is there any one thing about the resurrection that plagues your faith?

If yes – have you read any of McDowell's, Strobel's or Habermas' books?

6. Does anything stand out to you about the Apostles' Creed?
