Why would he do that?

Did how God feels about sin shock you or bother you?

How would you feel if He said those things and spoke that way to you?

4. Have you ever heard someone use the phrase “God of the Old Testament”?
How is that wrong?

5. Why do you think we are tempted to “soften” how God feels toward sin?

6. What are the ramifications of the fact that Americans and the church are just as guilty of the list of sins that Judah and Israel committed?
