

7 Reasons Not to Date THAT Guy

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Proverbs 18:22 Message

Find a good spouse, you find a good life-- and even more: the favor of GOD!

Who is THAT guy?

1. THAT guy who spends more time on his looks than you do.

One can appreciate a well-groomed man, but if he spends too much time in front of the mirror, this could mean one of two things: he's either very vain, or very insecure, or possibly both.

Vain and insecure people tend to take a lot more than to give – his constant need for approval could wear you down after a while.

2. THAT guy who cheated on an ex-girlfriend

When infidelity occurs early in relationship the betrayal is almost impossible to overcome. If you cannot lay a foundation of trust you have nothing to build on.

If he cheated to be with you, how do you know he won't do it to you?

3. THAT guy who can't keep a job

Is he committed to personal growth?

Does he have a vision for his life?

If he can't grow himself, he will never grow your relationship.

4. THAT guy your friends don't like
